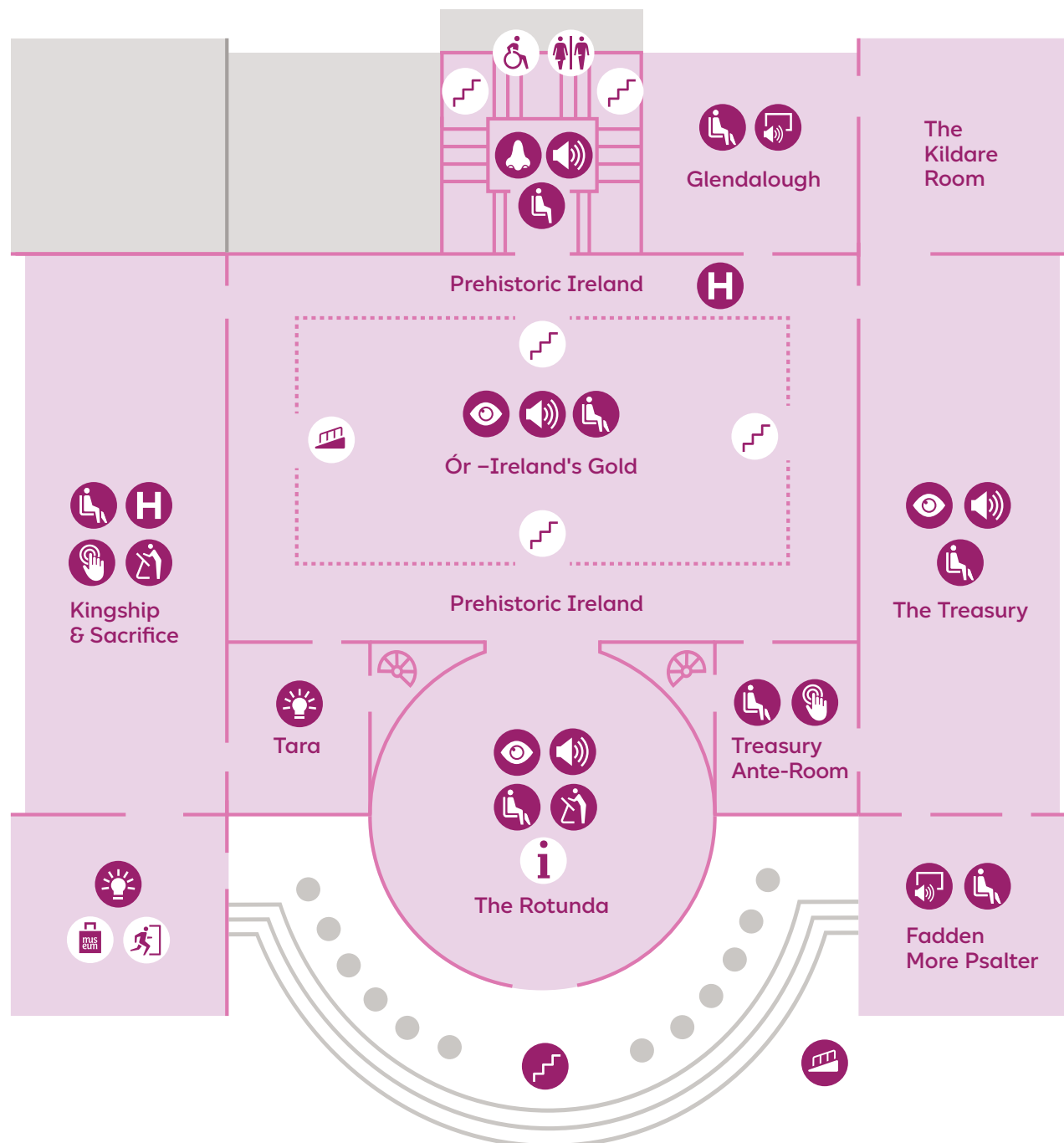


Kildare Street Ground Floor

Emotional Trigger Zones

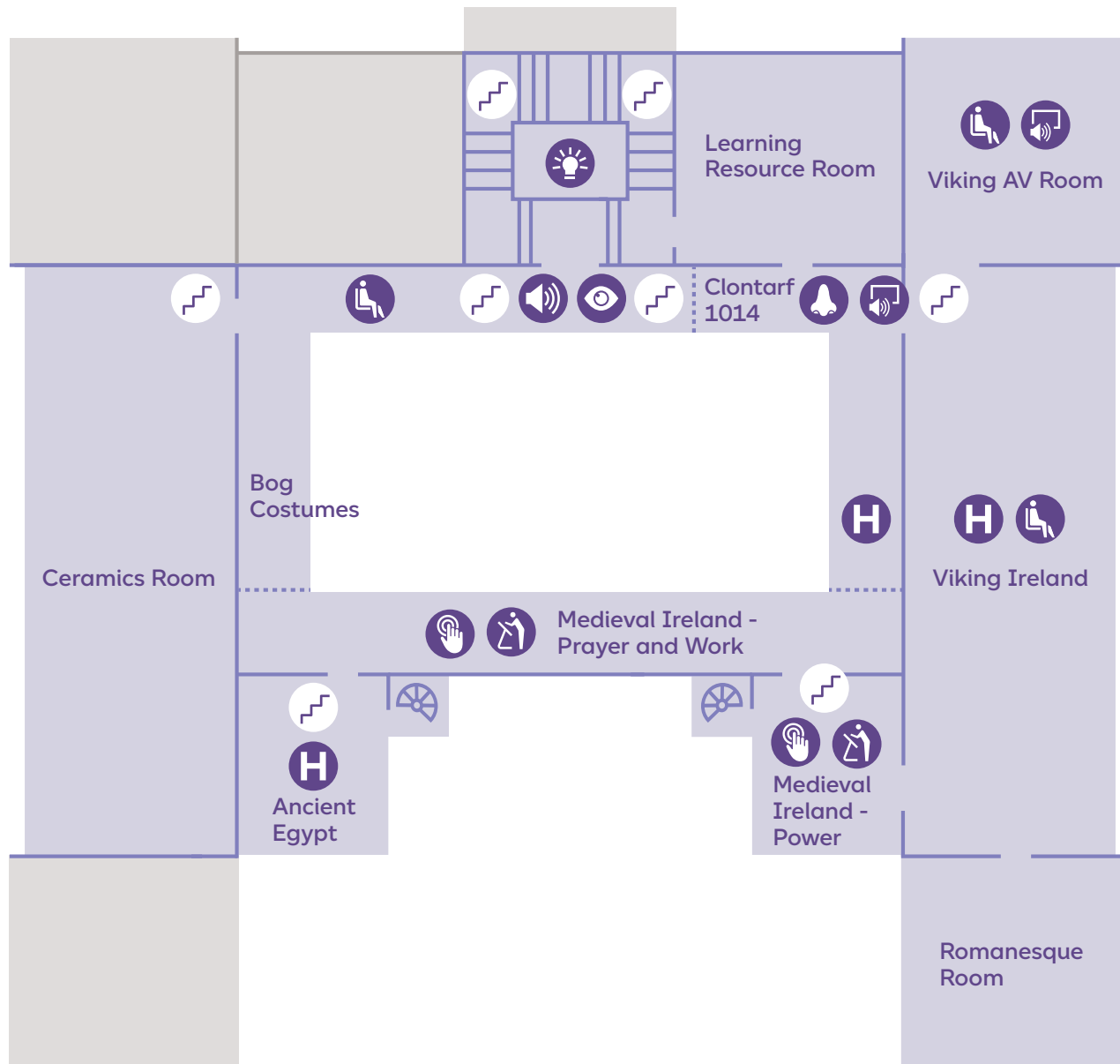
Prehistoric Ireland - There are two displays of human remains in this exhibition. One is an inhumation burial and the second is a cremation burial.

Kingship and Sacrifice - There are four, very well preserved, human remains on display. Each of them are on display inside a large circular pod that you can walk into.
